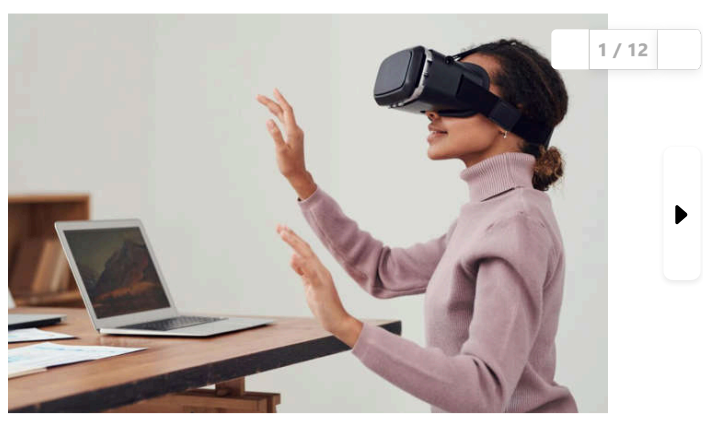

# Central NY weekend forecast: Another inch or two of snow before the rain begins

Syracuse, N.Y. — Get out and enjoy the snow Friday and Saturday because it'll start to melt away Sunday, according to the National Weather Service.

Snow flurries will continue across much of Central New York Friday and Saturday, though only about an inch or less is expected each day. A winter storm warning for much of the region has been lifted.

Still, [many schools were on a two-hour delay this morning.](#)

And parts of Oneida and Oswego counties remain under a winter storm warning.

There, and in parts of Onondaga and Madison counties north of the Thruway, winds are expected to pick back up again Friday night, the service forecast.

That will drive intense lake effect snow bands across parts of those northern communities, especially in northern Oneida Counties. There, snow could fall at rates of 1 inch per hour at times on Saturday, according to the weather service.

Closer to Syracuse and through the rest of Central New York, the lake effect snow is expected to taper off midday today as wind speeds decrease.

Another inch or so of snow could fall tonight, then again on Saturday. Low temperatures Friday and Saturday nights will be in the low 20s.

But Sunday, those temperatures will rise. That's when the rain moves in, according to this morning's forecast.

It could be in the low 40s on Sunday, with a low that night above freezing.

Then rain is likely on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday.
