Conference Location

Where is the conference being held?

The conference is being held July 11-15, 2021, at the Town and Country Resort & Convention Center, San Diego, California. The address is 500 Hotel Circle North, and the phone number is (619) 291-7131.

Registration

When will registration open?

Registration is now [open](#). Registration will only be accepted online. If you have extenuating circumstances, please contact conferences@ncsc.org.

What does my registration include?

Registration includes the Sunday welcome reception, the Monday business lunch, the Tuesday evening social event, the Wednesday exhibit lunch, the Thursday business breakfast, and entry into all education sessions.

When will I receive confirmation of my registration?

Once you have completed your online registration and process credit card payment, you will receive a confirmation by email. If you do not receive this confirmation in 24 hours, please email [conference services](#).

May I attend the conference if I live outside of the continental US?

Due to California's public health orders, International travelers may only attend if fully vaccinated. For more information, please see the California Department of Public Health's most recent [memo](#).

If I am unable to attend, can I transfer my registration to someone else in my organization?

Hotel & Transportation

What hotels are providing room blocks for the conference? What are the rates?

The conference hotel is the Town and Country Resort & Convention Center, San Diego, California. Reservations can only be made after you register for the conference. A link will be sent to you in your confirmation email. The NACM room rate is \$196 per night plus taxes, single/double occupancy. This rate is available only through June 17, 2021, or until the NACM room block is full.

Can I make a hotel reservation now?

No, reservations can only be made once you register for the conference.

How do I get from the airport to the hotel?

The [Town and Country's website](#) lists driving and trolley directions. A typical UberX fare is \$12-14 and Lyft fare is \$15-18 from San Diego International Airport, and by taxi it's an average of \$35.

Is there parking available at the hotel?

Parking is \$18 per day for hotel guests, \$24 per day for local attendees.

Is there a hotel shuttle to take me to local attractions?

Hotel shuttle service to Riverwalk Golf Club, Fashion Valley Center, Old Town Mission Valley Center, and Hazard Center. Daily 10 a.m. -7 p.m., based upon availability. Shuttle pick up and drop off is located at the Hotel Lobby.

Exhibit Show

What day is the Exhibit Show?

The Exhibit Show will take place on Wednesday, July 14, from 10:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Lunch is included.

Where is it being held?

The Exhibit Show is being held in the Golden State Exhibit Hall.

Complimentary Wi-Fi will be available in the conference area and in guest rooms.

What other amenities does the hotel offer?

The hotel service fee is waived for NACM attendees and includes guest room Wi-Fi, unlimited access to the fitness center, hotel shuttle to Riverwalk Golf Club, Fashion Valley Center, Old Town Mission Valley Center, and Hazard Center daily from 10am-7pm based upon availability. Shuttle pick up and drop off is located at the hotel lobby. Guest Room local calls and 800 calls. Coffee in guest rooms. USA Today in Hotel lobby and dining outlets.
