## **MINUTES**

- Jude Del Preore gave an update on the Midyear Conference educational content and noted the extension of the Annual Conference call for proposals to Friday February 18, 2022.
- Tina discussed the CORE committee's progress on finalizing the curriculum review of the Operations Management competency, the commencement of the review of Court Governance competency and the inclusion of DEI (diversity, equity and inclusion) in all of the competencies has begun, starting with the Leadership competency.
- Norman led a discussion on the National Bankruptcy Court Clerks, LEAD
  Academy as an educational forum that could dovetail with the current
