GOVERNANCE COMMITTEE NOTES

In lieu of a committee conference call this month, we will provide you with an update on this committee's duties and projects. Subcommittee reports:

- National Agenda This subcommittee met in early February and has since disseminated a survey to be posted (pending permission) on the COSCA listserv. Additionally, the subcommittee will seek input from representatives of NASJE and CCPIO who we also hope to distribute said survey. This survey will provide guidance on additional measures to assist in framing the document that will become the third iteration of the NACM National Agenda at the end of 2020.
- State of the Profession Address This subcommittee met in late February and created a detailed outline for this important speech given by the president at the annual conference. The committee will reconvene on Tuesday, March 24 with the first draft of the SOP address.
- Ethics Peter Kiefer reports the list of state judiciary ethics codes and state ethics boards' opinions continues to grow.
