



Minutes of October 7, 2021 Education Committee meeting

The meeting commenced at 2:03 p.m. ET with the approval of the September minutes.

Conference Development report –

- Jeffrey T indicated that the outlines for midyear and annual conferences are being finalized, incorporating SIGs back into the agenda. The call for proposals has been extended for midyear for 2 more weeks with the annual proposals still open until the beginning of December. We have received proposals over the weekend, but are still looking for a few more before giving them to the Proposal Review subcommittee.
- The Board met last week and solidified the conference rates (both early bird and regular, as well as the livestream attendance rate.) We are still hoping that we won't have to cancel and do the entire conference virtual.

CORE report –

- Tina M reported she had two individuals to assist with the Court Governance curriculum, but asked the group to offer any names of individuals who might be able to assist with this topic. When the CORE subcommittee meets on October 27th, we will be determining how to divide up the curriculum to add DEI into the opening of each one, similar to how it was done for Leadership and Operations Management.

State Associations Report –

- Rick reported to the Committee of the State Associations landing page would include links to all identified state associations from the fifty states. Included with the links would be documents provided by the state associations such as conference agendas, strategic plans, and association bylaws.

Suggested Projects and Strategic Plan initiatives

- Rick outlined the Education Committee's charge in relation to selecting items to be worked on either by the Communications or CORE committees.

The Strategic Plan will be fully vetted in December by the Board, but Rick hopes to have some of the priority initiatives available for this group to review in November. Rick asked committee members to send him any topics they might want to see this group tackle.
