





#### MISSED COURT DATES DRIVES ARREST AND JAIL

### **Leading Cause of Arrest in Michigan** More People Arrested in Michigan for Missing Court than for Assault, DUI Most arrests by offense type, 2018 29,295 28,264 21,410 Operating a vehicle Simple assault "Failure to appear" under the influence of alcohol

#### MISSED COURT DATES ARE COSTLY

#### **ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS**

Each missed appearance: ~\$1100+

**10,000** missed court dates

**1,000** missed **\$1.1** M



### IDEAS42: USING BEHAVIORAL SCIENCE TO INCREASE APPEARANCE AND DECREASE WARRANTS





We use insights from human behavior – why people do what they do – to help improve lives, build better systems, and drive social change.



### (UN)WARRANTED: OUR WORK INCREASING COURT APPEARANCE RATES ACROSS THE COUNTRY

### Court date communications proven to:

- Reduce nonappearance, and move cases forward
- Improve efficiency, save time & money
- Increase equitable access to justice

### Partner with state and local courts to create effective communications:

- Court date forms (citations, release forms, notices...)
- Court date reminders
   (text, email, phone, mail...)



### Target: Prevent 500K missed court dates over 5 years






#### **ASSUMPTION: PEOPLE MISS COURT INTENTIONALLY**

#### Traditional model of behavior: How we **BELIEVE** people act








INTENTION

### COURT IS OFTEN DESIGNED FOR TWO TYPES







### THINKING BEHAVIORALLY, WE CAN UNCOVER THE REAL DRIVERS BEHIND NONAPPEARANCE

Many barriers keep people from getting to court despite their best efforts






Information people receive may be unclear, incomplete, or confusing

When people are afraid or disempowered, they may decide it's best not to show up

When key resources are scarce, we focus on what is most urgent






### COGNITIVE BANDWIDTH IS OUR ABILITY TO DO "EXECUTIVE" THINKING...

# We all have limited cognitive bandwidth



### WHEN OUR COGNITIVE BANDWIDTH IS DEPLETED, IT AFFECTS OUR BEHAVIOR





#### SCARCITY DEPLETES OUR COGNITIVE BANDWIDTH

**Scarcity:** When vital resources (money, food, time) are in short supply



- We focus on the scarcity to exclusion of all else
- Depletes our cognitive bandwidth
- Like a tight deadline
- Adaptive in the short term

**Chronic scarcity:** Living in a continual state of scarcity (like experiencing poverty)

- Like be no her a light work dea line of day, every day Like losing a night's sleep!





# IMPROVING COMMUNICATIONS PROVEN STRATEGY

# Strongly backed by research

Communications interventions have been found to increase appearance rates by as much as **20-40%** 

# Often highly cost effective

Redesigning forms can **cost little or nothing**; text reminders **cheap to run** after initial investment

# Something all courts can do

Even **small improvements** can go a long way

# MAKE INFORMATION CLEAR, TIMELY, ACCESSIBLE: ROUNDUP OF LEADING PRACTICES





**Behaviorally designed court forms:** Citations, summonses, bond paperwork, agreements to appear, notice of next court date, and more.



**Reminders:** Text, call, email, or mail (or best - a combination). Sent prior to court date and after missed hearing.



**Post-arraignment meetings:** Voluntary meeting with court staff, paired with reminders prior to next court date.



# Redesigned summons form (NYC)

Simple updates like bringing most important info to the top and encouraging appearance while reminding of consequences increased attendance





# Redesigned notice of next court date (Harris County, TX)

New form emphasizes court date, reduces legalese, explains what to expect at court, and encourages sign up for reminders

# Text reminders (NYC)

- One-way text messages emphasizing consequences, what to expect, and plan-making reduced nonappearance by 26%
- Combined with missed court date reminder, open warrants fell 32%
- Higher impact for court users with less wealth



### Live calling (NYC)

- Reminder phone calls reduced nonappearance by 37%
- Evaluation found higher impact for people of color



### Postcards (Nebraska)


- Postcards emphasized consequences of nonappearance
- Nonappearance rates fell from 13% to 8%

# Missed Court Date Rates: New Summons Form




# Missed Court Date Rates: **Text Message Reminders**




Data for reminders reflects percentage impact of most effective reminders

# MAKE INFORMATION CLEAR, TIMELY, ACCESSIBLE: POST-ARRAIGNMENT MEETINGS

### WHAT IT IS AND HOW IT WORKS

- A brief, voluntary post-arraignment meeting with trained pretrial staff
- Helps court users clarify appearance obligations and make a plan to return to court.
- Court users also receive a personalized reminder call before their next court date

#### THE EVIDENCE

In a pilot, the program
 reduced nonappearance
 by 32% over the
 remainder of a person's
 case





# LEADING STRATEGIES TARGET COMMON PAIN POINTS

**STRATEGY** 

#### **BARRIERS ADDRESSED**

# **Virtual appearances**

Offer virtual appearances with accessibility and procedural fairness

✓ Transportation, childcare, and other barriers to going to court in person

### **Warrant clearing**

Provide streamlined warrant-clearing processes with a no-arrest guarantee

✓ Fear



# EXAMPLES: ACCESSIBLE VIRTUAL APPEARANCES

### Courts have seen impressive participation in virtual appearances

**68% decrease** in nonappearance; 1100 warrants avoided

(El Paso, TX, April 2020-2022)

Nonappearance in eviction proceedings **fell from ~40% to ~13%** 

(Maricopa County, AZ, 2019-2021)

# Courts are working to make virtual appearances accessible and procedurally just

# REDUCE LOGISTICAL CHALLENGES: WARRANT CLEARING




### WHAT IT IS AND HOW IT WORKS

- Lowers fear of arrest that rises after warrant
- Streamlined processes and/or special events that remove hassles and address court users' fear of arrest when clearing a warrant for nonappearance, helping cases to get back on track more quickly.
- Models include regular outreach events by court personnel, community-based services, special dockets, and periodic events

#### THE EVIDENCE

 Examples of streamlined warrant clearing haven't been rigorously studied, but courts have seen impressive numbers of warrants cleared

# FLEXIBILITY HELPS COURT USERS MEET THEIR OBLIGATIONS



Rigid schedules and procedures are especially difficult for court users dealing with scarcity

# COURTS ARE FINDING WAYS TO CREATE SLACK

### Flexible (re)scheduling

- Allowing court users to (re)schedule certain hearings
- May work best for high volume charge types (citable, etc.)
- Example: Salt Lake City Municipal Court arraignment scheduling

### **Grace periods**

- Reduce warrants for missed appearances
- Length and requirements vary
- Example: 48-hour grace period in NY State
