Most recently the National Judicial Task Force to Examine State Courts' Response to Mental Illness alluded to the need to stop the criminal justice system's revolving door with the mentally ill. Given this advocacy, shouldn't we add recidivism as a performance measure to the Trial Court Performance Standards?
